

**Gallery Crawl**  
**April 12, 2008 6 to 9:30 pm**

This year our Gallery Crawl is bigger and better than ever, hence it has it's own weekend! Park in Davidson Commons or Cornelius Town Hall and ride to all the different venues on a **Trolley!** In Davidson, the Crawl will start at some of the new businesses at exit 30. Aquesta Bank will host Pierre Fraser of Huntersville and Joe Thompson of Charlotte. Pierre works mostly with acrylic and watercolor and gets inspiration from the natural world. Joe creates in acrylics, enamel on Plexiglas, and printmaking. Stop in Monkees of Lake Norman, where they will be presenting works by artist Felicia van Bork.

Board the Trolley, sponsored by WDAV, Downtown Davidson Inc., and the Town of Cornelius, and ride to the Belk Visual Arts Center of Davidson College, where mixed media artist Tonya J. Clay will have her paintings on display. There will also be exhibits by Davidson College students and faculty. At Harris Teeter you will see several artists from Art on the Green featured there.

Along Main St in Davidson, stop in the So Alive! Gallery to see "Angelic Presence" by Gloria Morina Syverson, sponsored by the Charlotte Writer's Club. Continue along Main St and stop in one of the many businesses, such as the Knox Realty, the Needlecraft Center, Davidson Village Inn, or Market Properties, that will be open featuring Art on the Green artists. Whistling Swan Gallery will have guest artist Susan Daul exhibiting her fraktur art. These stylized, highly decorative watercolor and ink paintings are in the Pennsylvania-German tradition, often bearing elaborate calligraphy and standardized motifs.

Davidson College Presbyterian Church will open their Congregation House and feature art by members of their congregation. Davidson Town Hall is another stop, where local artist Ann Sloan will be presenting her photography and Iretha Kerns displays her mixed medium pieces.

Board the **Trolley** again and make your way to S. Main, where Seaweed Designs Art Boutique showcases the inspired and innovative works of local and national artists. Come meet V. Yeager Brown, Cathy Walling, Marcela Hosmann and Cathy McQueen. The boutique's art takes the form of paintings, glass, pottery, mosaics, stained glass, tiles, home décor and handmade garden yard art.

The Wooden Stone will host potter Julie Wiggins. Her pots are intended for everyday use that dictates a function throughout cultures and time. Julie is currently a resident with Clayworks Inc and has also worked with the McColl Center for Visual Arts, the Community School for the Arts, and Charlotte Mecklenburg Schools, all in Charlotte.

At the Merrill- Jennings Gallery enjoy the exhibit "Art of the Landscape" featuring oils by Paul Keysar and Susan Jennings, giclees by Ray Byram, watercolors by Virginia Quillen and many others artists works.

Ride the **Trolley** to Cornelius and stop at Cornelius Town Hall. Lake Norman Art League artists will treat you to a show. These local artists mediums range from woodturning by David Kaylor to paintings by Jane Ellithorpe, to name but a few. Next stop then takes you to the Cornelius Arts Center. At the Creative Art Exchange you will see works from Greensboro watercolorist Alexis Lavine. Her award winning paintings have been included in numerous juried and gallery exhibitions, and they hang in private and corporate collections throughout the country, as well as overseas.

Many of your stops will be offering refreshments and featuring live music to enjoy as you Crawl.
